8 **AMENDED ORDER**

9 WHEREAS, this Court issued an order on August 3, 2021, establishing the
10 Working Interdisciplinary Network of Guardianship Stakeholders (Network);

11 WHEREAS, the order provided for the appointment of Network members by
12 the Chief Justice, including one (1) or more members of an Indian nation, tribe or
13 pueblo located wholly or partly in New Mexico to be appointed by future order of
14 the Chief Justice; and

15 WHEREAS, in light of the foregoing and the Chief Justice wishing to appoint
16 Tribal Judge William Bluehouse Johnson to be a member of the Network;


17 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Honorable William
18 Bluehouse Johnson is appointed to serve in the representative capacity as a member

1 of an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo located wholly or partly in New Mexico for an
2 initial term of four (4) years and is thereafter eligible for reappointment.

3 IT IS SO ORDERED.
